# Our Topic - Let Us Entertain You?

# **Nativity**

The children we be learning some Christmas songs and rehearsing our KS1 Nativity 'Lights, Camel Action!' The children will perform the Nativity alongside Reception and Year 2. Details on parts and costumes will be sent out shortly but as always if you have any questions please see your child's class teacher.

# **Reading at Home**

In order to encourage children to read daily, we would like to remind the class about our **Reading Challenge**. There are lots of children who are nearing the <u>50</u> home reads and will soon receive their Bronze certificate in assembly! Please continue to support your child with daily reading at home and help us to monitor this by numbering each reading entry in your child's reading record, <u>one number per day</u> (rather than one each time they read). Children in Year 1 should be coming home with 2 x RWI phonics books, a colour banded book every week. If you find this not to be the case please speak to the class teacher so we can resolve this. It is important that your child's reading books and Reading Diary are in their book bag <u>every day</u> as we like to take every opportunity to read!

### Half-Term Challenge: 10 Things to Do Before You're 7!

A reminder we would really like to see your child take part in our Bucket list challenge. Please help your child to record this by **taking photos**, **drawing pictures**, **or writing** about their experiences and posting them on Tapestry. Any evidence sent in will be shared and celebrated within the classroom.

This half term we are focussing on learning a new skill. This could be <u>anything</u> that your child learns to do as part of a club or individually. Here are just a few suggestions:

- Ride a bike
- Swim 5 metres
- Do a handstand or cartwheel
- Earn a badge at a club .i.e. Rainbows/Scouts

We are encouraging our Year 1 children to develop their independent skills and part of this is looking after their own P.E kits (including jumpers and coats) and putting things away where they belong.

As the weather is unpredictable at this time of year it would be great if we could have your child's wellies in school so we can continue to use the outside area as part of our daily learning. We will always try to get outside whatever the weather, so please can you also ensure your child has a warm waterproof coat in school otherwise they may not be able to go out with their peers. Please remember that although we always encourage the children to wear aprons, your child will encounter many messy activities throughout the day so please do not send them to school in coats that are considered expensive, or their best clothes.
